- Review of March test -- CA
 - Oakland did a good job hosting the test
 - An issue of unprofessionalism was discussed

 - o Can I bring my own map sheets?
 - Yes, as long as it is the FEMA approved map sheet or it will need to be transferred to the FEMA approved map sheet.
 - Where does the total number of floors in a building go and where does the number that you searched go? Do I need to know this for the test?
 - You do not need to know this for the test. It would go under the incomplete or the completed search.
 - Can I use a GPS for mapping in Type I?
 - Yes, but it is not required.
 - o Do I put the TIME IN under the name of our TF in the building marking system X?
 - Yes you do, but it is the search marking system, not the building search marking.
 - Can my dog wear a coat during the long down if its cold?
 - Yes
 - On the limited access pile, if I return to my start point after finding my first victim, my
 I go back to the first victim location again?

- You can only access the pile if the dog alert
- o Review: Though the CSC suggests in the Policies that a pretest is good for 6 months, a pretest can be mandated by a TF at any time for any reason.
- o Review: Dog must execute stop and turn on the actual obstacle (not the support)
