- 2) **TN CSST**
? The format of the Oct CA CSST is dependent upon whether the TN course will be offered. Teresa will contact TN.
- 3) **Disastersearch v. disasterdog**
? The name cannot be changed
- 4) **K9 roster**
? The roster will be maintained by the Subcommittee and forwarded to the Canine Coordinators by the Division Reps after each Certification Evaluation.

5) Canine TF questionnaire

? Almost completed and ready for distribution.

6) Out of system HRD cert

? ARDA has agreed to update the Disaster Cadaver-Dog Standards written for NDMS and Beta-tested in Fairfax in March, 2000. ARDA will then make it available to all canine handlers. The CSC will review the revision and upon CSC approval, will acknowledge the standard as a suggested guideline for certification of disaster HRD dog teams. This is subsequent to the many requests for a guideline for HRD training and certification. **The CSC is not promoting HRD training and/or testing and FEMA grant funds may not be used for either.**

7) Videos

? Debra has set up a site for videos to be reviewed by the CSC for posting on the website. Any videos accepted by the CSC will be posted on the website for use. Examples are videos for Task Force Education concerning the canine resource and videos directed to the new canine handler.

8) Lead Evaluator App—Elizabeth Kreitler VA-TF1 handler

? Approved

9) New Evaluators—Jackie McCarty IN-TF1 handler, Bud Souza CA-TF4, handler

? Approved

10) Evaluators bringing dogs

? Subsequent to many complaints, the following parameters have been decided upon for Evaluators bringing dogs with them to CEs/CPs: they must arrange their own transportation and lodging, realizing that some TFs have no mechanism for reimbursement. It cannot impact the CE/CP in any way. This is in lieu of mandating that evaluators cannot bring dogs, ever. If there are more complaints, the issue may be re-visited.

11) K9 Decon list & packs

? The Vet Group has submitted them for approval by the CSC for forwarding for inclusion in the Cache

12) Confined Space—PD

? The Rescue WG has submitted a recommendation which was approved by Ops to have canine (among others) be required to take operations level training as opposed to awareness (which is the current requirement). As an alternative, a suggestion was made to add pertinent skill sets to the CSST. (How would we grandfather those already checked off for the CSST?). Tabled until the RWG rec becomes a directive or not.

13) Parameters for applicants for tests and CPs

? For an interim procedure—we will follow the same process as the CSST. Each TF will have the opportunity to submit two applications for a CE/CP. They may submit one more as a stand-by. Once all of the TFs have had their opportunities, the stand-by's will be accepted, in order of receipt.

? The announcement should come out at least 60 days prior to the event. At 90 days out, the Division Rep will give the TF a “reminder”.

? Discussion as to one central point for all applications for all tests (CSC?). To be discussed further.

? Structure for CP: (No FSA—must have completed FSA prior)

Day one—mock test (run just like the test, but evaluator won't allow “mistakes” to be made by handler.

Day two—training based on day one performances

14)Review of CA test

? Discussion of importance of documentation by evaluators, especially when failing a team. Needs to be supporting evidence. Point addressed that cover sheet doesn't allow for performance on different piles. Need to address poor search strategy and poor knowledge of search markings at next canine coordinator call.
